THE STATE'S ATTORNEY OF CALVERT COUNTY SHALL BE ALLOWED SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$600.00) ANNUALLY FOR CLERICAL EXPENSES.

(f). The State's Attorney of Harford, St. Mary's, Talbot and Wicomico Counties shall each receive an annual salary of \$3,000.

The State's Attorney of St. Mary's County shall be allowed Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) annually for clerical expenses.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

## CHAPTER 657

## (House Bill 663)

- AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 7 (i) 4 of Article 72 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Oysters and Clams", sub-title "Dredging in County Waters", clarifying the line between Wades Point and Second Kent or Long Point, in Talbot County.
- Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 7 (i) 4 of Article 72 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Oysters and Clams", sub-title "Dredging in County Waters", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
- 7. (i) 4. Talbot County Only—The waters lying between a line drawn from Lows Point to Bloody Point Lighthouse and a line drawn from Wades Point Farm House to Wades Point bell buoy and thence from Wades Point bell buoy to Second Kent or Long Point.
- Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.
