ISTING SALARIES SUBJECT TO APPLICABLE REG-ULATIONS OF THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY PER-BOARD. SONNEL THECOMMISSION SHALL PROMPTLY TRANSFER TO THE COUNTY MANAGER OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY ALL ITS BOOKS, RECORDS, PAPERS, DOCUMENTS, MAPS AND EQUIPMENT USED IN CONNECTION WITH FUNCTIONS TRANSFERRED. ALL FUNDS OF THE COMMISSION ON HAND ON THE DATE THE PRO-VISIONS OF THIS ACT TAKE EFFECT AND DE-RIVED FROM FEES COLLECTED BY SAID COMMIS-SION UNDER THE AUTHORITY CONFERRED BY THE SECTIONS REPEALED BY SECTION 1 OF THIS ACT, SHALL BE PROMPTLY PAID OVER TO MONT-GOMERY COUNTY, AND SUCH FUNDS SHALL BE ALLOCATED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL TO THE APPROPRIATE LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES FOR EXPENDITURE. NOTWITHSTANDING PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, THE APPROVAL OF THE MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING COMMISSION AS TO ZONING. SHALL FIRST BE OBTAINED, PRIOR TO THE ISSU-ANCE OF ANY BUILDING PERMIT.

SEC. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT THE MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING COMMISSION ANDMONTGOMERY COUNTY ARE HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND EMPOW-ERED TO ENTER INTO SUCH COMMITMENTS AND AGREEMENTS AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO EFFEC-TUATE THE TRANSFER FROM THE COMMISSION TO THE COUNTY OF THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE RECREATION PROGRAM HITHERTO DUCTED BY THE SAID COMMISSION WITHIN THE MARYLAND-WASHINGTON REGIONAL DISTRICT WITHIN MONTGOMERY COUNTY AND THE EXTEN-SION OFTHE SAID PROGRAM THROUGHOUT MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PROVIDED THAT BEFORE ADMINISTRATION OF THAT PART OF THE SAID RECREATIONAL PROGRAM CONDUCTED WITHIN CAPPER-CRAMTON PARKS IS SO $_{
m THE}$ TRANS-FERRED THE CONSENT AND APPROVAL OF THE NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING COM-MISSION SHALL FIRST BE OBTAINED.

SEC. 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT NOVEMBER 1, 1951.
