## CHAPTER 672

## (Senate Bill 294)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Subsection (11) of Section 7 of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Revenue and Taxes," sub-title "Ordinary Taxes. What Shall Be Taxed and Where," increasing the exemption for farming implements.

SECTION 1. Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sub-section (11) of Section 7 of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Revenue and Taxes," sub-title "Ordinary Taxes. What Shall Be Taxed and Where," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

7.

- (11). **[**Five Hundred**]** Three Thousand FIFTEEN HUNDRED Dollars in value of the farming implements of any farmer.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

## CHAPTER 673
