(h) Any convalescent patient from a Veterans' Hospital who is hospitalized for service connected disabilities may fish without securing a license provided he secures a permit issued by a special service officer or the American Red Cross under authorization granted by the Game and Inland Fish Commission.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 109

(House Bill 158)

AN ACT to add a new sub-section to Section 6 of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages", sub-title "Beer Licenses", said new sub-section to be known as Sub-section (fa) and to follow immediately after Sub-section (f) of said section; to add a new sub-section to Section 7 of said Article, to be known as Sub-section (ga) and to follow immediately after Sub-section (g) of said section; to add a new sub-section to Section 9 of said Article, to be known as Sub-section (ia) and to follow immediately after Sub-section (i) of said section; to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-section (g) of Section 11 of said Article, sub-title "Beer and Light Wine Licenses"; to add a new sub-section to Section 12 of said Article, to be known as Sub-section (ga) and to follow immediately after Sub-section (g) of said section; to add a new sub-section to Section 14 of said Article, to be known as Sub-section (ea) and to follow immediately after Sub-section (e) of said section: and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Subsection (f) of Section 17 of said Article, sub-title "Beer, Wine and Liquor Licenses"; providing for increasing the annual license fees for certain classes of alcoholic beverage licenses issued in Montgomery County.
