

ing Article 1A of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "City of Cumberland", sub-title "Workmen and Wages", providing that the wages and salaries paid to general city employees and officers as of January 1, 1951, shall be the minimum amount to be paid thereto.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 160 of the Charter of the City of Cumberland (1950 Edition, being Article 1A of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "City of Cumberland", sub-title "Workmen and Wages", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

160. The base wage and/or salary of all general city employees and officers, with the exception of casual or temporary employees, and employees on probation, and members of the police and fire department, shall be the wage or salary paid said employees and officers, whether on an hourly or monthly basis, as of [March 31, 1943, plus thirty per cent of said wages or salary paid said employees and officers on either an hourly or monthly basis as of March 31, 1943.] *January 1, 1951. Such base wage or salary shall be the minimum amount to be paid to employees and officers in the respective employment and positions.*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 154

(House Bill 237)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 272 of the Baltimore County Code (1948 Edition), being Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Baltimore County", sub-title "Protection of Wild Life and Birds", relating to the carrying of firearms in certain areas of Baltimore County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 272 of the Baltimore County Code (1948
