CHAPTER 169

(Senate Bill 145)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 6A of Article 51 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Juries," sub-title "Qualification and Selection of Jurors," said section having been enacted by Chapter 595 of the Acts of 1947, qualifying women to serve on juries in Washington County.

SECTION 1. Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 6A of Article 51 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Juries," sub-title "Qualification and Selection of Jurors," said section having been enacted by Chapter 595 of the Acts of 1947, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

6A. Hereafter no person shall be disqualified for service as a juror in this State by reason of sex, but the provisions of law relating to the qualifications of jurors and exemption from jury duty shall in all cases apply to women as well as men, and the lists from which jurors are drawn shall include the names of men and women. The provisions of this Section shall not apply to Allegany, Calvert, Carroll, Charles, Garrett, Queen Anne's, Talbot, Worcester, Howard, St. Mary's and Kent [and Washington] Counties.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.
