CHAPTER 173

(Senate Bill 167)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 134 of Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Talbot County," sub-title "Easton," said section having been amended by Chapter 444 of the Acts of 1947, relating to the boundary lines of the wards in the Town of Easton.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 134 of Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Talbot County," sub-title "Easton," said section having been amended by Chapter 444 of the Acts of 1947, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

134. Easton shall be divided into four wards, bounded as follows:

FIRST WARD shall be bounded on the North and West by the boundaries of the Town, and on the East by a line running *Southwardly with the center-line of Centerville Road to the center of Aurora Street, thence Southwardly with the center-line of Aurora Street to the center of Goldsborough Street, thence, Westwardly to the intersection of the center-line of Goldsborough Street with the center-line of Hanson Street; thence, Southwardly with the center-line of Hanson Street to its intersection with the center-line of Brookletts Avenue; thence, Westwardly with the center-line of Brookletts Avenue to its intersection with the center-line of Washington Street; thence, Northwardly with the center-line of Washington Street; thence Northwardly with the center-line of Washington Street to its intersection with the center-line of Biery Street; thence,*
