78A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition and 1947 Supplement), title "Public Works—Board of," said new section to be known as Section 13A, to follow immediately after Section 13 thereof and to be under the sub-title "Federal Projects," and to read as follows:

13A. The Board of Public Works may purchase or acquire otherwise, in its discretion, in the name of the State of Maryland, out of any funds which may be set aside for such purposes, the land and interests in land which are necessary to be acquired for establishment of the Harpers Ferry National Monument, authorized to be established by the Act of Congress approved June 30, 1944, (58 Stat. 645). Upon acquisition of the said properties, the Board of Public Works is authorized to convey all right, title, and interest therein whatsoever held by the State of Maryland to the United States for purposes of the said Harpers Ferry National Monument. In the event the Board of Public Works shall find that the most expeditious method of acquiring the said land for the national monument would be to transfer and donate the necessary funds to the United States for such purposes, the Board may transfer and donate to the United States. on behalf of the State of Maryland, any of the funds which are available or which may hereafter become available to it for purposes of this section upon condition that such funds, when so conveyed to the United States, shall be used solely by the United States for the acquisition of land and interests in land, and expenses incidental thereto, required for establishment of the Harpers Ferry National Monument.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.
