

CHAPTER 214

(Senate Bill 210)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 142 (a) of Article 11 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Banks and Trust Companies," sub-title "Credit Unions," increasing the amount of loans which may be made by credit unions without security.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 142 (a) of Article 11 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Banks and Trust Companies," sub-title "Credit Unions," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

142 (a). A credit union may loan to its members for such purposes, and upon such security and terms as the by-laws shall provide, and the credit committee may approve, but security need not be taken for any loan of ~~three hundred dollars (\$300.00)~~ *four hundred dollars (\$400.00)* or less, or for the sum of ~~three hundred dollars (\$300.00)~~ *four hundred dollars (\$400.00)* in any case where the loan is in excess of said amount.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 215

(Senate Bill 217)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 222 and 223 of Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Cecil County," sub-title "Jurors," relating to the number of jurors to be selected from each Election District in Cecil County.
