CHAPTER 276

(House Bill 388)

AN ACT to repeal Sections 4 and 5 of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages", sub-titles "Manufacturer's Licenses" and "Wholesaler's Licenses", and to enact in lieu thereof three new sections to be known as Sections 4, 5 and 5A and to be under a new sub-title "Manufacturer's and Wholesaler's Licenses", relating to the granting of manufacturer's and wholesaler's licenses for alcoholic beverages.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 4 and 5 of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages", sub-titles "Manufacturer's Licenses" and "Wholesaler's Licenses", be and the same are hereby repealed; and that three new sections be and they are hereby enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as Sections 4, 5 and 5A and to be under a new sub-title "Manufacturer's and Wholesaler's Licenses", and to read as follows:

MANUFACTURER'S AND WHOLESALER'S LICENSES

4. (a) *The following classes of manufacturer's licenses shall be issued at the designated annual fees:*

<i>Class 1</i>	<i>Distillery</i>	<i>Annual Fee</i>	<i>\$1,500.00</i>
<i>Class 2</i>	<i>Rectifying</i>	<i>Annual Fee</i>	<i>500.00</i>
<i>Class 3</i>	<i>Winery</i>	<i>Annual Fee</i>	<i>500.00</i>
<i>Class 4</i>	<i>Limited Winery</i>	<i>Annual Fee</i>	<i>50.00</i>
<i>Class 5</i>	<i>Brewery</i>	<i>Annual Fee</i>	<i>1,000.00</i>

(b) *Distillery License. A Class 1 Manufacturer's License shall be designated as a Distillery License and shall authorize*
