tration of any pension or retirement fund or system are hereby authorized to issue rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of this section, any present rules and regulations to the contrary notwithstanding.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1951.

CHAPTER 295

(Senate Bill 152)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 43B of Article 27 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Contraceptives—Sale by Vending Machines," eliminating the provision permitting sale of contraceptives in places where alcoholic beverages are sold for consumption on the premises.

MACHINES," PROVIDING THAT CONTRACEPTIVES MAY NOT BE SOLD IN PLACES WHERE

TIVES MAY NOT BE SOLD IN PLACES WHERE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE SOLD FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES IN HOWARD COUNTY.

SECTION 1. Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 43B of Article 27 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1947 Supplement), title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Contraceptives—Sale by Vending Machines," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

43B. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to sell or offer for sale any contraceptive or contraceptive device by means of a vending machine or other automatic device whether or not such contraceptive or contraceptive device is advertised as such or as a prophylactic, fexcept in places where alcoholic beverages are
