

(e-a) The State's Attorney of Howard County shall receive an annual salary of \$2,600.

CHAPTER 533

(House Bill 653)

AN ACT to add a new sub-section to Section 30 of Article 66½ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Motor Vehicles", sub-title "Administration—Registration—Titling", said new sub-section to be known as Sub-section (e) of said section, to follow immediately after Sub-section d) of said section, providing that the Department of Motor Vehicles may issue special registration plates for motor vehicles upon request and payment of an additional fee to an applicant who has not been convicted of any violation of the law involving a motor vehicle actually in motion within a certain period.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new sub-section be and it is hereby added to Section 30 of Article 66½ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Motor Vehicles", sub-title "Administration — Registration — Titling", said new sub-section to be known as Sub-section (e) of said section, to follow immediately after Sub-section (d) of said section and to read as follows:*

30.

(e) The Department may, upon the payment of a fee of ~~Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)~~ FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$15.00), which shall be in addition to and not in substitution of the fees required by this Article, issue to any applicant registration plates upon which shall be displayed any combination of letters and/or numerals requested by the applicant and approved by the Department. Provided,
