more, pending the hearing of such appeal, upon furnishing surety to be fixed by the said justice for his appearance in the Criminal Court of Baltimore, or upon furnishing such surety for his said appearance as the Criminal Court of Baltimore may require.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

## CHAPTER 541

## (House Bill 702)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 40 (e) of Article 10 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact", sub-title 'State's Attorney", providing for the appointment of a Deputy State's Attorney for Washington County, and setting his salary, effective January 1, 1955.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 40 (e) of Article 10 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact", sub-title "State's Attorney", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, and to read as follows:

- (e) The State's Attorney shall of Washington County shall receive an annual salary of \$2,500. On January 1, 1955 the State's Attorney shall appoint a Deputy State's Attorney who shall receive an annual salary of \$2,400.00.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 1955.
