

CHAPTER 542

(House Bill 703)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 40 (k) (9) of Article 10, of the Annotated Code of Maryland, (1951 Edition), title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact", sub-title "State's Attorney", increasing the expense allowance of the State's Attorney of Washington County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 40 (k) (9) of Article 10, of the Annotated Code of Maryland, (1951 Edition), title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact", sub-title "State's Attorney", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, and to read as follows:

40. (k)

(9) The State's Attorney of Washington County shall receive **[\$1,500]** ~~\$2,000.00~~ \$2,500 for the expenses of his office.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 543

(House Bill 704)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 206 of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Licenses", sub-title "Dog Licenses in the Counties", limiting the circumstances under which damages for destruction by dogs shall be paid in Washington County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 206 of Article 56 of the Annotated
