CHAPTER 542

(House Bill 703)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 40 (k) (9) of Article 10, of the Annotated Code of Maryland, (1951 Edition), title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact", sub-title "State's Attorney", increasing the expense allowance of the State's Attorney of Washington County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 40 (k) (9) of Article 10, of the Annotated Code of Maryland, (1951 Edition), title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact", sub-title "State's Attorney", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, and to read as follows:

40. (k)

- (9) The State's Attorney of Washington County shall receive [\$1,500] \$2,000.00 \$2,500 for the expenses of his office.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 543

(House Bill 704)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 206 of Article 56 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Licenses", sub-title "Dog Licenses in the Counties", limiting the circumstances under which damages for destruction by dogs shall be paid in Washington County.
