SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sub-sections (f) and (g-a) of Section 40 of Article 10 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact", sub-title "State's Attorney", be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

40.

(f) The State's Attorneys of Harford, St. Mary's, and Talbot [and Wicomico] Counties shall each receive an annual salary of \$3,000.

The State's Attorney of St. Mary's County shall be allowed Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) annually for clerical expenses.

- (g-a) The State's Attorneys of Cecil [County] and Wicomico Counties shall receive an annual salary of \$4,000.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 579

(House Bill 899)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 100 of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Allegany County", subtitle "County Commissioners", as said section was amended by Chapter 610 of the Acts of 1947, increasing the salary of the Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners of Allegany County.
