- (c). The Town Commissioners of Sudlersville, Queen Anne's County may, in their discretion, re-assess or make a separate assessment, for the purposes of township taxation only, of all property real or personal, subject to ordinary taxation, within the corporate limits of said Town.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.
