SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new sub-section be and it is hereby added to Section 12 of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Revenue and Taxes," sub-title "By Whom Assessments Shall Be Made," said new sub-section to be known as Sub-section (c), to follow immediately after Sub-section (b) of said Section, and to read as follows:

12.

(c). The Town Commissioners of Sudlersville, Queen Anne's County may, in their discretion, re-assess or make a separate assessment, for the purposes of township taxation only, of all property real or personal, subject to ordinary taxation, within the corporate limits of said Town.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 612

(Senate Bill 312)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 400 (a) of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Revenue and Taxes", sub-title "Admissions and Amusement Tax", relating to the exemption of Agricultural Fairs from the Admissions and Amusement Tax.
