CHAPTER 615

(Senate Bill 347)

AN ACT to add a new section to the Montgomery County Code (1950 Edition), being Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Montgomery County", sub-title "Washington Grove", said new section to be known as Section 115-4A and to follow immediately after Section 115-4 of said Code, to extend the boundaries of the Town of Washington Grove, to include a certain area in Montgomery County.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the Town of Washington Grove in Montgomery County, Maryland, a majority of more than two-thirds of the voters of said town on July 14, 1951, approved the annexation of certain land to said town as hereinafter described; now therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That a new section be and it is hereby added to the Montgomery County Code (1950 Edition), being Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Montgomery County", sub-title "Washington Grove", said new section to be known as Section 115-4A, to follow immediately after Section 115-4 of said Code, and to read as follows:

*115-4A. (a). The boundaries of said Town of Washington Grove are hereby extended to include the following area in Montgomery County, which is hereby added to said Town: All of that tract or tracts or parcels of land lying in Montgomery County known as part of Crabb's Fortress comprising 46 $\frac{3}{4}$  acres more or less, owned by the Town of Washington Grove as of July 14, 1951, and bordered on the east by the Gaithersburg-Laytonsville Road.*
