Governor for the unexpired term, and until a successor shall qualify. Any member of a county board shall be eligible for reappointment, unless otherwise disqualified by the provisions of this section.

12A. The Governor shall appoint a County Board of Education for Prince George's County, the Board to be composed of six (6) persons, two (2) of whom shall be members of that political party which polled the second highest number of votes in the most recent gubernatorial election in the State. One (1) member of the Board of County Commissioners of Prince George's County, to be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of Prince George's County, shall serve on the County Board of Education for Prince George's County in addition to those six (6) persons appointed by the Governor. The terms of office of the members to be appointed by the Governor as of June 1, 1953, under the provisions of this section, shall correspondingly be designated so that the several members of the Board of Education, as comprised on June 1, 1953, shall have terms of one, two, three four and five years, respectively, as of the first Monday in May of each year, one person to fill the vacancy of the member whose term is then expiring. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent the Governor from appointing to any Board appointed under the provisions hereof, any person who may have served on any previous Board of Education in Prince George's County. Except as in this section specified, the provisions of Section 6 hereinabove shall continue to apply to the Board of Education of Prince George's County.

THE BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY SHALL BE COMPOSED LEAST TWO OF SEVEN PERSONS. AT SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THAT POLITICAL PARTY WHICH POLLED THE SECOND HIGHEST NUMBER RECENT GUBERNA-THE MOST VOTES IN TORIAL ELECTION IN THE STATE. THE GOVER-NOR SHALL APPOINT TO SAID BOARD **CITIZENS** PRINCE ARE OFWHO PERSONS GEORGE'S COUNTY. OF THE PERSONS FIRST AP-POINTED, FIVE SHALL HAVE TERMS OF ONE, TWO, THREE, FOUR AND FIVE YEARS, RESPEC-TIVELY, AND THE OTHER TWO SHALL HAVE TERMS OF SIX YEARS, ALL DATING FROM THE FIRST MONDAY IN MAY, 1953. THOSE PERSONS WHO ARE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF EDUCA-TION FOR PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY IMMEDI-
