

*Seven Locks Road to Randolph; thence easterly about 2.7 miles along the aforesaid line to its intersection with a line 300 feet southwest of and parallel to the center of the Rockville-Washington Road; thence northwesterly about 2.3 miles along the aforesaid line to its intersection with the southern boundary of the Town of Rockville, as defined by Sections 902, 903, 904 and 905 of Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland and amended by Chapters 202 and 204 of the Laws of Maryland of 1941; thence easterly, southeasterly and northwesterly about 1.9 miles along the aforesaid boundary to its intersection with a line 300 feet north of and parallel to the center of the Rockville-Norbeck Road; thence northeasterly about 4.2 miles along the aforesaid line to its intersection with a line 300 feet west of and parallel to the center of the Norbeck-Brookeville-Brighton-Dayton Road; thence, northerly about 8.6 miles along the aforesaid line to its intersection with the Montgomery-Howard County Line; thence southeasterly about 11.9 miles along the aforesaid County Line to a common corner of the Montgomery, Howard, and Prince George's Counties; thence southwesterly about 2.5 miles along the Montgomery-Prince George's County Line to its intersection with the present dividing line between Election District No. 1 (Vansville) and Election District No. 10 (Laurel) in Prince George's County; thence generally easterly and southeasterly 5.0 miles along the aforesaid line to its intersection with the present western boundary line of Election District No. 14 (Bowie); thence generally southwesterly about 0.9 mile along the aforesaid line to its intersection with the Fairfield Road; thence generally southeasterly about 2.2 miles along the aforesaid road to its intersection with the Beaverdam Road; thence generally southeasterly about 3.5 miles along the Springfield-Hillmead Road to its intersection with the present southern boundary line of Election District No. 14 (Bowie); thence generally southwesterly about 0.9 mile along the aforesaid line to its intersection with the present easterly boundary line of Election District No. 13 (Kent); thence generally southerly about 6.4 miles along the aforesaid line to its intersection with the present southern boundary line of Election District No. 13 (Kent); thence generally westerly about 3.4 miles along the aforesaid line to its intersection with the present easterly boundary line of Election District No. 6 (Spaulding's); thence southerly about 300 feet along the aforesaid line to its intersection with a line 300 feet southeast of and parallel to the center line of the Ritchie-Forestville Road; thence generally southwesterly and southerly about 2.1 miles along the*
