

*the center line of Halpine Avenue, thence running in an Easterly direction with the center line of Halpine Avenue to intersect the Southerly extension of the Division line between the Subdivision of Twin Brook and the property of Robert A. Pugh, thence running in a Northerly direction with said division line, so as to include said Pugh Property, a distance of 200 feet, more or less, to the existing Corporate limits of the Town of Rockville.*

§5. 2. *And be it further enacted, That a new section be and it is hereby added to said Montgomery County Code and to the Prince George's County Code (1943 Edition), being Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, titles "Montgomery County" and Prince George's County", sub-title "Washington Suburban Sanitary District", said new sections to be known as Sections 130-18D and 1420H, respectively, and to follow immediately after Sections 130-18C and 1420G thereof, and all to read as follows:*

*130-18D. (1420H). The boundaries of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District are diminished so as to exclude the following area: Beginning for the same at the point of intersection of the due East boundary line of the Washington Suburban Sanitary District as described in Section 1280 of the Laws of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission, with the division line between the Woodmont Country Club and the Congressional Airport Properties, and running thence in a generally Southwesterly direction with said division line to the most Westerly common corner of said Woodmont Club and Airport Properties, thence continuing with the lines of said Airport Property in an Easterly direction a distance of 1184 feet more or less to a corner of said Property, thence running across said Property on an extension of said line so as to exclude a part of said Property, Easterly 400 feet to a corner thereof, thence again running with the lines of said Property, Easterly 1322 feet more or less to the Southeast corner thereof, thence running with the East line of said Airport Property a distance of 968 feet, more or less, to the division line between the property of Arthur C. Hyde, formerly the James H. Wagner Property, and the property of Councilman and Bowie, thence running in an Easterly direction with said division line and an extension thereof, to the center line of the Washington Rockville Pike, U. S. Route No. 240, thence running in a Southerly direction with said center line to intersect the Westerly extension of the division line between the Brandenburg Tract, and*
