

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY FOR WHICH HE WAS APPOINTED, IN THE PENALTY OF FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00), UPON THE CONDITION EXPRESSED IN EACH OF SAID BONDS THAT THE SAID JUSTICE GIVING IT WILL TRULY AND FAITHFULLY DISCHARGE, EXECUTE AND PERFORM ALL AND SINGULAR THE DUTIES AND OBLIGATIONS OF A CLERK, AND THAT HE WILL ACCOUNT FOR AND PAY OVER TO THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY, OR TO WHOMSOEVER ELSE MAY BE OTHERWISE OR HEREAFTER DESIGNATED BY LAW AS THE PROPER RECIPIENT THEREOF, ALL FEES, COSTS, FINES, PENALTIES AND FORFEITURES WHICH HE IS BOUND TO ACCOUNT FOR AND PAY OVER AS AFORESAID, AND THAT HE WILL FAITHFULLY AND TRULY ACCOUNT FOR AND PAY OVER TO THE PERSON OR CORPORATION ENTITLED THERETO ALL MONEY BELONGING TO SUCH PERSON OR CORPORATION WHICH MAY COME INTO HIS HANDS AS SUCH CLERK.

(B) EVERY CLERK OTHER THAN THE CLERK APPOINTED BY THE TRIAL MAGISTRATE OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY SHALL, BEFORE ENTERING UPON HIS DUTIES, GIVE A CORPORATE BOND SIMILARLY CONDITIONED, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000.00.

(C) THE PREMIUMS OF ALL BONDS REQUIRED BY THIS SUB-TITLE SHALL BE PAID BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.
