

(f). Trial Magistrates of Dorchester County, MONTGOMERY COUNTY and Talbot County shall have civil jurisdiction in all cases hereinbefore mentioned in this section, instituted after June 1 ~~[1949,]~~ 1953, and involving amounts not exceeding ~~[Three]~~ five Hundred Dollars.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

## CHAPTER 646

(Senate Bill 522)

AN ACT to repeal Section 17(e) of Article 17 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Clerks of Courts," sub-title "General Duties of Clerks," and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 24(g) thereof, and to re-letter Section 24(f), (g) and (g-1) thereof to be Sections 24(e), (f) and (g), respectively, raising the salary of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Garrett County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 17(e) of Article 17 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Clerks of Courts," sub-title "General Duties of Clerks," be and it is hereby repealed and that Section 24(g) of said Article be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, and that Sections 24(f), (g) and (g-1) be and they are hereby re-lettered to be Sections 24(e), (f) and (g), respectively, and all to read as follows:

~~[(g)]~~ (f) The Clerks of the Circuit Courts of Caroline, Dorchester, *Garrett*, Somerset and Worcester Counties shall each be entitled to receive an annual salary of \$4,500.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.
