

If a majority of the votes cast at said election in the County of Queen Annes on said question shall be "For Court House Construction", then this Act shall automatically become effective in said county. If a majority of the votes cast in said county on said question shall be "Against Court House Construction", then this Act shall not become effective in said county.

SEC. 5 4. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 648

(Senate Bill 545)

AN ACT to repeal Section 27 (a) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Alcoholic Beverages", sub-title "Local Licenses and License Provisions", and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 19 (b) and 21 (b) of said Article, sub-title "Beer, Wine and Liquor Licenses", relating to the license fee for restaurant and tavern licenses in Allegany County and deleting provisions defining the word "restaurant" in Allegany County.

AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTIONS 9 (B), 14 (B), 19 (B), AND 27 (A) OF ARTICLE 2B OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND (1951 EDITION), TITLE "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES", SUB-TITLES "BEER LICENSES", "BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSES", "BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSES", AND "LOCAL LICENSES AND LICENSE PROVISIONS"; TO REPEAL AND RE-ENACT, WITH AMENDMENTS, SECTIONS 9 (K), 14 (L), 16 (I), 19 (L), AND 21 (B) OF SAID ARTICLES AND SUB-TITLES; TO ADD SECTION 16 (A-1) TO SAID ARTICLE, SUB-TITLE "BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSES", SAID NEW SECTION TO FOLLOW IMMEDIATELY AFTER SECTION 16 (A) THEREOF, REVISING
