AMOUNT NECESSARY TO SUPPLEMENT CONSTRUC-TION FUNDS AVAILABLE TO FINANCE THE PRO-POSED ROAD PROGRAM DURING THE FIRST FOUR PROGRAM YEARS, AS SAID PROGRAM COSTS ARE SET FORTH IN THE DOCUMENT ENTITLED "ROAD CONSTRUCTION AND RECONSTRUCTION IN THE PROPOSED TWELVE YEAR PROGRAM", AND DATED OCTOBER 27, 1952, COPIES OF WHICH DOCUMENT SHALL BE SIGNED ON THE FRONT THEREOF BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE STATE ROADS COMMISSION AND SHALL BE FILED WITH EACH OF THE FOLLOWING: THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, THE CLERK OF THE COURT OF APPEALS OF MARY-LAND, THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE REFER-ENCE OF MARYLAND AND THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE ROADS COMMISSION OF MARYLAND: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THE STATE ROADS COMMIS-SION UNDER THE AUTHORITY GRANTED IN SEC-TION 162A OF THIS ACT SHALL AT NO ONE TIME ISSUE BONDS IN AN AMOUNT GREATER THAN \$25,000,000.00. AND FURTHER PROVIDED THAT NO BONDS SHALL BE ISSUED UNTIL THE CASH BAL-IN THE COMMISSION'S CONSTRUCTION ANCE FUND IS BELOW \$25,000,000.00; PROVIDED, HOW-EVER, THAT THE LIMITATION ON THE AMOUNT OF BONDS THAT MAY BE ISSUED AT ANY ONE TIME SHALL NOT BE DEEMED TO INCLUDE ANY BONDS ISSUED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SEC-TION 162G OF THIS ACT. PRIOR TO THE END OF FOUR YEAR PERIOD NEXT SUCCEEDING THETHE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT, I. E., ON OR BEFORE THE 31ST DAY OF JANUARY, DURING THE 1957 SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEM-THE STATE ROADS COMMISSION BLY.SHALL PRESENT TO THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE AND TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, A REPORT OF THE RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS OF THE COMMIS-SION FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT TO DECEMBER 31, 1956. SAID REPORT SHALL ALSO IN-CLUDE A SUMMARY OF THE PROGRAM PROGRESS THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 1956. AFTER LEGISLA-TIVE REVIEW OF THE DECEMBER 31, 1956 REPORT, AND SUCH OTHER LEGISLATIVE INQUIRY AS MAY BE DEEMED APPROPRIATE, THE GENERAL AS-SEMBLY MAY, BY APPROPRIATE ACTION, PROHIBIT THE ISSUANCE OF ADDITIONAL BONDS PROVIDED FOR IN THIS ACT, OR MAY RESTRICT THE AMOUNT
