

## CHAPTER 666

(House Bill 176)

AN ACT to add a new section to the Code of Public Local Laws of Montgomery County (1947 Edition), being Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Montgomery County", sub-title "Gaithersburg", said new section to be known as Section 431A of said Article and to follow immediately after Section 431 thereof, extending the boundaries of the town of Gaithersburg.

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION TO THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY (1950 EDITION), BEING ARTICLE 16 OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF MARYLAND, TITLE "MONTGOMERY COUNTY," SUB-TITLE "GAITHERSBURG," SAID NEW SECTION TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 107-3A, TO FOLLOW IMMEDIATELY AFTER SECTION 107-3 THEREOF, AND TO ADD A NEW SECTION TO THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY (1943 EDITION), BEING ARTICLE 17 OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF MARYLAND, TITLE "PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY," SUB-TITLE "WASHINGTON SUBURBAN SANITARY DISTRICT," SAID NEW SECTION TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 1420H AND TO FOLLOW IMMEDIATELY AFTER SECTION 1420G THEREOF, AND TO ADD A NEW SECTION TO THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY, SUB-TITLE "WASHINGTON SUBURBAN SANITARY DISTRICT," SAID NEW SECTION TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 130-18B, AND TO FOLLOW IMMEDIATELY AFTER SECTION 130-18A OF SAID CODE, EXTENDING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF GAITHERSBURG AND THE BOUNDARIES OF THE WASHINGTON SUBURBAN SANITARY DISTRICT.

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new section be and it is hereby added to the Code of Public Local Laws of Montgomery County
