cared for or treated following an operation or sickness and for such treatment a compensation is paid.

- Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.
- SEC. 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT NOTHING IN THIS ACT SHALL APPLY TO ANY PLACE LICENSED AND REGULATED BY THIS STATE.
- SEC. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT JUNE 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 670

(House Bill 270)

- 60B. (a) The Clerk of the Circuit Court for Allegany County is authorized and directed to establish a separate index of FILED AND recorded Conditional Sale Contracts, a separate index of recorded Chattel Mortgages and a
