

not exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) the Board of County Commissioners of Baltimore County shall be required to accept informal bids from three or more persons or corporations unless the entire project can be completed by a County Department or by County equipment and employees of Baltimore County.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 678

(House Bill 351)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-sections (f) and (h) of Section 176 of Article 66½ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Motor Vehicles", sub-title "Operation of Vehicles Upon Highways", relating generally to the operation of a motor vehicle at a speed that is greater than is reasonable and safe under certain conditions.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sub-sections (f) and (h) of Section 176 of Article 66½ of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Motor Vehicles", sub-title "Operation of Vehicles Upon Highways", be and they are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

176.

(f) Violation of paragraphs (a), (b), (c), and (h) of this section shall be deemed to be a misdemeanor and any person upon conviction shall be fined not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). Violation of Paragraph (d) shall be deemed to be a misdemeanor and any person upon conviction shall be fined not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
