

ARUNDEL, KENT, WORCESTER, FREDERICK, DORCHESTER, TALBOT, CALVERT AND MONTGOMERY COUNTIES.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That all laws or parts of laws, whether public local or public general, inconsistent with the provisions of this Act be and they are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 685

(House Bill 395)

AN ACT to add ~~nineteen~~ TWENTY new sections to Article 11 of the Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Frederick County", said new sections to be known as Sections 751A to ~~751S~~ 751T, inclusive, under the new sub-title "Trailer ~~Camps~~ PARKS", and to follow immediately after Section 750 of said Article, providing for regulation, licensing and taxing of trailer coaches and trailer coach parks in Frederick County OUTSIDE OF THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF ANY MUNICIPAL CORPORATION WHICH HAS ENACTED AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAILER COACHES AND TRAILER COACH PARKS, and providing penalties for violation thereof AND PROVIDING FOR APPEALS FROM ORDERS ISSUED BY THE BOARD OF HEALTH.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That ~~nineteen~~ TWENTY new sections be and they are hereby added to Article 11 of the Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Frederick County", said new sections to be known as Sections 751A to ~~751S~~ 751T, inclusive, under the new sub-title "Trailer ~~Camps~~ PARKS", and to follow immediately after Section 750 of said Article, and all to read as follows:
