Anne Arundel County, who shall review, after due notice of hearing, the Commission's decision. If the County Commissioners shall find that the cost of installing such facilities, plus the unamortized balance of the cost of facilities theretofore installed in said sub-district by the Sanitary Commission, will not exceed fourteen per centum (14%) of the assessed property value as fixed for County taxation purposes within said area, and if they find that the proposed project is feasible from an engineering and financial standpoint, and if in addition thereto they shall find that it is to the best interest of the sub-district involved that such facilities be installed, they may in their discretion reverse the decision of the Commission, in which event they may direct the Commission to proceed with the installation of such facilities as may be ordered by the County Commissioners; and the decision of the County Commissioners shall be final.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and having been passed by a yea and nay vote, supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly of Maryland, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 709

(House Bill 591)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Subsection SUB-SECTIONS (B) AND (p) of Section 38 Article 87 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Sheriffs", sub-title "Compensation and Duties", relating to the compensation of the Sheriff of Prince George's County AND ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTIES and his deputies, CLERKS and stenographer.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sub-section SUB-SECTIONS (B) AND
