(p) of Section 38 of Article 87 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Sheriffs", sub-title "Compensation and Duties", be and it is THEY ARE hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

38.

- (B) THE SHERIFF OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY SHALL RECEIVE AN ANNUAL SALARY OF \$3,000. HE SHALL BE ALLOWED \$17,400 PER YEAR FOR DEPUTIES AND CLERICAL ASSISTANCE COMMENCING FROM JUNE 1, 1953. IN ADDITION THERETO THE SHERIFF SHALL RECEIVE AN ALLOWANCE FOR EXPENSES IN THE SUM OF \$2,000 PER ANNUM IN MONTHLY INSTALLMENTS, ACCOUNTING FROM JUNE 1, 1953. COMMENCING WITH THE BEGINNING OF THE NEXT TERM OF OFFICE, THE SHERIFF OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY SHALL RECEIVE AN ANNUAL SALARY OF \$7,500 AND NO OTHER COMPENSATION.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.
