If a majority of the votes cast in said election shall be "~~For Storm Water or Surface Drainage Improvement Bonds~~ CHANGE IN METHOD OF DRAINAGE ASSESSMENT", then this Act shall immediately become effective, but if a majority of the votes cast in said election shall be "~~Against Storm Water or Surface Drainage Improvement Bonds~~ CHANGE IN METHOD OF DRAINAGE ASSESSMENT", then this Act shall be of no effect and shall be null and void.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 731

(House Bill 781)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 289 of the Charter and Public Local Laws of Baltimore City (1949 Edition), being Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Baltimore City", sub-title "Orphans' Court", as said section was amended by Chapter 377 of the Acts of 1951, ~~increasing the~~ RELATING TO THE MINIMUM AND maximum salary which may be paid to the Bailiffs of the Orphans' Court of Baltimore City.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 289 of the Charter and Public Local Laws of Baltimore City (1949 Edition), being Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Baltimore City", sub-title "Orphans' Court", as said
