from assessment and from state, county, and city taxation in this State.

SECTION 1. Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new sub-section be and it is hereby added to Section 8 of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Revenue and Taxes", sub-title "What Shall Be Taxed and Where", said new section to be known as Sub-section (38) of said Section 78 and to follow immediately after Sub-section (37) thereof as said sub-section was enacted by Chapter 447 of the Acts of 1951 and to read as follows:

- (38) All young poultry, including chickens, ducks, turkeys and guineas, not more than 6 months of age and not kept for reproductive purposes.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

## CHAPTER 756

## (Senate Bill 284)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, subsection (k) of Section 250 of Article 93 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Testamentary Law," sub-title "Orphans' Court", providing for the payment of pensions to the Judges of the Orphans' Court", providing for the payment of pensions to the Judges of the Orphans' Court of Baltimore City, under certain conditions.

SECTION 1. Beit enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sub-section (k) of Section 250 of Article 93 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Testamentary Law," sub-title "Orphans' Court", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
