pended Balance of the Commission which said County may credit, as hereinafter provided, against the amounts payable by said County to said Commission pursuant to said Section 2-VII in the next succeeding fiscal year. When said County receives the certification from the Commission of its Net Unexpended Balance with respect to said County, as above defined, said County may, if it so elects, deduct said Net Unexpended Balance from its estimate of the amount of money which will be raised in the next succeeding fiscal year by the levy of the tax provided for in said Section 2-VII and may, in such fiscal year levy said tax at a rate which said County estimates will produce an amount equal to the difference so arrived at, which said amount shall then be the amount which the County is obligated to pay the Commission in such fiscal year pursuant to said Section 2-VII; provided, always, that in no event shall the said tax rate be thereby reduced to a rate insufficient to produce the amount of money necessary to pay debt service on bonds issued by the Commission and quaranteed by said County.

- SEC. 5. And be it further enacted, That Section 2 A, of Chapter 992 of the Laws of Maryland of 1943, known as The Maryland Washington Regional District Act, which said Act is incorporated for convenience of reference in the Code of Prince George's County and in Montgomery County Code, 1950, as said Section 2 A was repealed and re-enacted with amendments by Chapter 374 of the Laws of Maryland of 1947, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows:
- A. The area fin within the combined boundaries of Montgomery and Prince George's Counties fwithin the boundaries hereinafter in this Section designated is hereby incorporated for the purposes hereinafter set forth, and shall be known as The Maryland Washington Regional District, hereinafter referred to as "The District" fig. provided that incorporated towns and municipalities located within said boundaries shall or shall not be included therein dependent upon the following circumstances:
- (a) All municipalities heretofore or hereafter incorporated and located within the boundaries of said District as the same were defined by Chapter 374 of the Laws of Maryland of 1947 and Chapter 123 of the Laws of Maryland of 1949, shall continue to be included within said District and subject to the provisions of this Act;
- (b) All municipalities and towns heretofore or hereafter incorporated and located within the boundaries of
