its intersection at Phelp's Corner with a line 300 feet south of and parallel to the Oxon Hill Road; thence, generally westerly and southwesterly about 1.5 miles along the aforesaid line to its intersection with the prolongation of the southwestern line of the Fort Foote Road: thence generally northwesterly and northerly about 0.1 mile along the aforesaid line and the western line of the Fort Foote Road to its intersection with the southern boundary line of the United States Government property known as St. Elizabeth Farm; thence generally westerly about 0.7 miles along the southern boundary line of the St. Elizabeth Farm and its prolongation to its intersection with a line 2640 feet southeast of and parallel to the Maryland-District of Columbia Boundary Line: thence due southwest about 2.0 miles along the aforesaid line to its intersection with the Maryland-Virginia Boundary Line: thence northerly about 0.7 mile along the aforesaid Boundary Line to its intersection with the Maryland District of Columbia Boundary Line: thence due northeast 10.0 miles along the aforesaid Boundary Line to the eastern corner of the District of Columbia: thence due northwest 10.0 miles along the aforesaid Boundary Line to the northern corner of the District of Columbia; thence due southwest about 6.0 miles along the aforesaid Boundary Line to the place of beginning.

- SEC. 6 5. And be it further enacted, That Sections 2-B, 2-C, 2-D and 2-G of Chapter 952 of the Laws of Maryland of 1945, be and the same are hereby repealed.
- SEC. 7 6. And be it further enacted, That Section 2-GG of Chapter 992 of the Laws of Maryland of 1943 and Section 2-OO added to said Chapter 992 by Chapter 582 of the Laws of Maryland of 1949, be and the same are hereby repealed.
- SEC. 8 7. And be it further enacted, That Section 2-CC of Chapter 992 of the Laws of Maryland of 1943 as repealed and re-enacted with amendments by Chapter 682 of the Laws of Maryland of 1951, be and the same is hereby CHAPTER 992 OF THE LAWS OF MARYLAND OF 1943 BE AND THE SAME IS HEREBY repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows:
- CC. For the purpose of paying the current operating or administrative expenses of the Commission, including the cost of the development of the plan of the District or any part of such plan and including the cost of the exercise of the powers and functions granted [by this sub-title] to the Commission, there shall be levied annually [, beginning with the next annual levy.] against all the assessable prop-
