*To the Clerk of the Court of Appeals:*

I, JOHN R. REEVES, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, pursuant to the direction contained in Section 203 of Article 33 of the Code of Maryland (1947 Edition) DO HEREBY CERTIFY, That at the General Election held on November 4, 1952, in the State of Maryland, an Act known as Chapter 142 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1951, was submitted to the voters of Allegany County, Maryland, for their adoption or rejection, under the provisions of Chapter 142 of the Acts of 1951, said Act being:

“An Act providing for jury service by women in Allegany County”.

AND I DO CERTIFY, That at said election 14,666 votes were cast in favor of the adoption of Chapter 142 of the Acts of 1951 and 9,195 votes were cast against the adoption of the said Act; and a majority being cast for the adoption of Chapter 142, the said Act has, therefore, been ratified by the voters of Allegany County.
