

County”, sub-title “St. Mary’s Hospital”, to be known as Section 202 $\frac{1}{4}$  and to follow immediately after Section 202 of said Article, authorizing the County Commissioners to appropriate no more than \$7,500 per year to the St. Mary’s Hospital, Inc., for the payment of a resident physician.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That a new section be added to Article 19 of the Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title “St. Mary’s County”, sub-title “St. Mary’s Hospital”, to be known as Section 202 $\frac{1}{4}$  and to follow immediately after Section 202 of said Article, and to read as follows:

202 $\frac{1}{4}$ . *The County Commissioners of St. Mary’s County are hereby authorized ~~and directed~~ to make an annual appropriation, not to exceed Seventy-five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500), to the St. Mary’s Hospital, Inc., for the hire of a resident physician.*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

## CHAPTER 97

(House Bill 261)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 46 of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title “St. Mary’s County”, sub-title “County Commissioners”, as said section was amended by Chapter 457 of the Acts of 1941, allowing a county commissioner to succeed himself in office.
