

“Cecil County”, sub-title “Charlestown”, said section having been enacted by Chapter 206 of the Acts of 1951, said section relating to the government of the Town of Charlestown during the month of January, 1952, and being now obsolete.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 84M of Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title “Cecil County”, sub-title “Charlestown”, be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 113

(Senate Bill 73)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 288A of Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title “Cecil County”, sub-title “North East”, said section having been amended by Chapter 9 of the Acts of 1939, correcting erroneous references therein.

WHEREAS, the provisions of Section 288A of the charter of the Town of Northeast contain misleading references which should be corrected; now therefore

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 288A of Article 8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title “Cecil County”, sub-title “North East”, said section having been amended by Chapter 9 of the Acts of 1939, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

288A. (a) The President and Commissioners of said town, as the same are at present constituted and functioning, are hereby authorized and directed not later than the
