North 40 degrees 19 minutes West 867.28 feet, thence by a curve to the right, having a radius of 118.32 feet, for a distance of 139.80 feet, thence North 27 degrees 09 minutes 30 seconds East 247.50 feet. thence by a curve to the right, having a radius of 129 feet, for a distance of 49.4 feet, thence North 41 degrees 00 minutes West 410.00 feet to an iron pipe set near the southeast side of Gordon Street extended, thence still North 41 degrees 00 minutes West 20.89 feet to the middle of Gordon Street extended, thence binding thereon, North 48 degrees 52 minutes East 561.38 feet to a point in the middle of Gordon Street, and thence, South 41 degrees 00 minutes East 19.42 feet to a concrete monument marked BTL 1929. thence still South 41 degrees 00 minutes East 413.78 feet to the beginning, as surveyed by Glen C. Deaton, July, 1952.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 165

(Senate Bill 192)

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 25 of the Acts of the Regular Session of 1950 and to re-enact the provisions of said Act with some changes; to authorize the County Commissioners to accept the conveyance of the Garrett County Memorial Hospital from the Executors of the estate of the late George W. Loar, and to affirm and ratify the resolution of the County Commissioners agreeing to accept said conveyance; to approve and ratify the conveyance from the Mayor and Town Council of Oakland of the land for the Garrett County Memorial Hospital; to create a Board of Governors to manage and operate said Hospital; to authorize the County Commis-
