

Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Elections", sub-title "Election Officials", relating to the compensation of the Supervisor of Elections in Talbot County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Sub-section (a) of Section 3 of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Elections", sub-title "Election Officials", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

3. (a) Each Supervisor of Elections appointed under Section 1 (a) or Section 1 (c) of this Article shall receive an annual salary as follows:

In Allegany County, \$900; in Anne Arundel County, \$800; in Baltimore City, \$3,190 until January 1, 1950, and thereafter \$5,000; in Baltimore County, \$1,800; in Calvert County, \$200; in Caroline County, \$300; in Carroll County, \$400; in Cecil County, \$300; in Charles County, \$250; in Dorchester County, \$400; in Frederick County, \$480; in Garrett County, \$300; in Harford County, \$400; in Howard County, \$400; in Kent County, \$400; in Montgomery County, \$1,200; in Prince George's County, \$1,000; in Queen Anne's County, \$300; in St. Mary's County, \$250; in Somerset County, \$300; in Talbot County, ~~[\$250]~~ \$300; in Washington County, \$600; in Wicomico County, \$400; in Worcester County, \$300.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.
