SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 67 of Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Talbot County", sub-title "County Commissioners", as said section was amended by Chapter 122 of the Acts of 1943, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

67. The County Commissioners of Talbot County shall each receive in lieu of the per diem and mileage provided in Section 65, an annual salary of ~~Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$750.00)~~ **One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00)** payable quarterly, ~~and all necessary traveling expenses when traveling on county business outside of the county,~~ *provided that the Chairman of the County Commissioners shall receive an annual salary of One Thousand and Two Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), payable quarterly.*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect January 1, 1955.

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## CHAPTER 179

(Senate Bill 288)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 6(h) of Article 25 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "County Commissioners", sub-title "General Powers", relating to the powers of the County Commissioner of Howard County to regulate certain nuisances or causes of sickness, and providing that a violation of any of the provisions of said Section or of any ordinance or regulation made thereunder shall be a misdemeanor.
