

Commissioners of the respective counties. The Judges of the Orphans' Court for Howard County shall receive an allowance for traveling expenses of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) per year. The Judges of the Orphans' Court for Somerset County shall receive an allowance of Four Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$4.50) for mileage for every day's attendance upon the sessions of said Court.

(ff) Each of the Judges of the Orphans' Court for Talbot and *Caroline Counties* **[County]** shall receive Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) for every day's attendance upon the sessions of said Court, not to exceed \$825 in any one year.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 189  
(Senate Bill 365)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, sub-section (b) of Section 6 of Article 52 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Justices of the Peace," sub-title "Civil Jurisdiction," and to add a new sub-section to said Section, said new sub-section to be known as sub-section (g) and to follow immediately after sub-section (f) of said Section relating to the civil jurisdiction of Trial Magistrates in Caroline County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That sub-section (b) of Section 6 of Article 52 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Justices of the Peace," sub-title "Civil Jurisdiction," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments; that a new sub-section be and it is hereby added to said Section, said new sub-section to be known as sub-section (g) and to follow immediately after sub-section (f) of said Section, and to read as follows:
