

ing, alterations or improvements, together with an estimate of the total cost of same and secure a permit from the Board of Assessments of Washington County. All permits shall be issued free of cost and may be obtained by written request or by personal application MAKE A REPORT OF THE BUILDING INTENTIONS TO THE SUPERVISOR OF ASSESSMENTS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY. SAID SUPERVISOR OF ASSESSMENTS SHALL ACKNOWLEDGE RECEIPT OF SUCH REPORT IN WRITING ON A SUITABLE FORM, AND NO FEE SHALL BE CHARGED THEREFOR. *Any person or corporation failing to comply with the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, be liable for a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). or not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each offense.*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 243

(House Bill 502)

AN ACT to repeal Section 113-21a and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 113-21b of the Montgomery County Code (1950 Edition), being Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Montgomery County", sub-title "Primary Elections—Generally", so as to specifically repeal the provisions for primary elections in the town of Rockville.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 113-21a of the Montgomery County Code (1950 Edition), being Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Montgomery County", sub-title "Primary Elections—Generally", be and it is hereby repealed and that Section 13-21b of said Code be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
