

as Section 147A and to follow immediately after Section 147 of said Article, empowering the Town Commissioners of Indian Head to make certain public improvements and to collect the cost as a tax against abutting property.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Charles County," sub-title "Indian Head," to be known as Section 147A and to follow immediately after Section 147 of said Article, and to read as follows:

147A. The Town Commissioners of Indian Head are hereby empowered to cause sidewalks along the public streets and highways of said Town to be graded, paved, repaired or improved; curbs to be set, gutters laid, and and sewer and water mains to be extended at the cost and expense of the abutting property or the owner thereof; and the cost thereof shall be a lien on the abutting property and the Commissioners are authorized to collect the same as in the case of other taxes levied under the Charter, or by ordinance passed in pursuance thereof.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 248
