47. (f) The County Treasurer of Howard County shall receive an annual salary of ~~[\$3,200.00]~~ \$4,000.00.

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## CHAPTER 249

(House Bill 523)

AN ACT to repeal Section 285 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Baltimore County (1948 Edition), being Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title “Baltimore County”, sub-title “Public Works”, sub-heading “Buildings,” said section having specified the manner in which a garage, when constructed as part of a dwelling, shall be built and maintained.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 285 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Baltimore County (1948 Edition), being Article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title “Baltimore County”, sub-title “Public Works”, sub-heading “Buildings,” be and it is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.
