terms and conditions as may be deemed appropriate by said Commissioners; provided, however, that no installment payment shall be permitted unless an agreement with respect thereto has been made by the property owner with the County Commissioners prior to the performance of the work.

- (b) The abutting property owners on any road, street or alley may petition the County Commissioners for construction or reconstruction of said road, street or alley. The abutting property owner on each side of said road, street or alley shall pay one-half of the cost of said road, street or alley, provided, however, that no property owner shall be liable for a width exceeding 15 feet for each side of the road, street or alley he abuts. Payment by such landowner or landowners may be made in annual installments not exceeding five in number as provided for in subsection (a) of this section.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.

CHAPTER 253

(House Bill 536)

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Charles County", sub-title "Indian Head", to be known as Section 150A and to follow immediately after Section 150 of said Article, authorizing the Town Commissioners of Indian Head to borrow \$30,000 upon the credit of said town; and to issue bonds on notes therefor, and to levy municipal taxes to retire such bonds or notes.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new section be and it is hereby added to Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Charles County", sub-title "Indian Head", to be known as Section 150A and to follow immedi-
