

+ or —; thence along the center line of Chicks Lane north $40^{\circ} 55'$ east, a distance of 1795 feet + or —; thence along Chicks Lane north $56^{\circ} 44'$ east, a distance of 1878 feet + or — to the center of Little Catactin Creek; thence along Little Catactin Creek the following 10 courses in distance: north $34^{\circ} 15'$ west, a distance of 435 feet + or —; thence north $30^{\circ} 55'$ east, a distance of 475 feet + or —; thence north $50^{\circ} 25'$ west, a distance of 610 feet + or — to the center of The Petersville Road Bridge; thence north $78^{\circ} 05'$ west, a distance of 584 feet + or —; thence north $40^{\circ} 45'$ west, a distance of 578 feet + or —; thence north $59^{\circ} 05'$ west, a distance of 425 feet + or —; thence south $43^{\circ} 07'$ west, a distance of 415 feet + or —; thence south $80^{\circ} 05'$ west, a distance of 525 feet + or —; thence north $76^{\circ} 50'$ west, a distance of 677 feet + or —; thence north $60^{\circ} 27'$ west, a distance of 845 feet + or — to the center of the Old Berlin Road Bridge across Little Catactin Creek. Thence along the center line of the Old Berlin Road south $27^{\circ} 50'$ west, a distance of 1768 feet + or —; thence continuing along said road south $65^{\circ} 35'$ east, a distance of 178 feet + or —; thence south $19^{\circ} 30'$ west, a distance of 1290 feet + or — to the corporate limits of Brunswick; thence along the corporate limits of Brunswick south $55^{\circ} 57'$ east, a distance of 1597 feet + or — to the place of beginning.

721C. *The citizens of Rosemont of the age of twenty-one years and over who shall have resided in said village for a period of ninety days next preceding the election shall elect by ballot on the first Saturday of May, in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-three, and biennially thereafter, at such place as shall be designated by the Burgess and Commissioners, a Burgess and four Commissioners, qualified in all respects as voters; and in addition thereto, the Burgess and each Commissioner shall be freeholders in Rosemont, and said Burgess and Commissioners shall hold office for the term of two years from the date of their election and until their successors are duly elected and qualified.*

721D. *All elections shall be held and conducted as shall from time to time be directed by the ordinances of the corporation not inconsistent with the provisions of this sub-title.*

721E. *In the event the Burgess or any one of the Commissioners shall die, resign, remove from said village or from any other cause be disqualified, the remaining Burgess and Commissioners shall elect by a majority vote a Burgess or Commissioners to fill the unexpired term.*
