experience and thereafter shall be \$4,600.00, and the salary schedule as set forth in Sub-section (d) above for teachers, with a degree, will thereupon and thereafter coincide with the minimum salary schedule as set forth in Sub-section (c) of Section 102 of Article 77, as amended by this Act.

Beginning with the school year 1956 1957, being in the State fiscal year ending on June 30, 1957, and each year thereafter, each teacher and principal shall be entitled to one annual increment in accordance with his or her qualifications and years of teaching experience, until the maximum is reached in accordance with this section.

AND FURTHER PROVIDED THAT, AFTER THE YEAR 1955-56, BOTH FOR THE PURPOSES OF ACTUAL MINIMUM SALARY PAYMENTS AND FOR THE PURPOSES OF EQUALIZATION, NOTHING CONTAINED HEREIN SHALL REQUIRE THE ACTUAL PAYMENT OR CALCULATION OF ANNUAL PAYMENT TO ANY TEACHER IN EXCESS OF THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00) ABOVE THE REQUIRED PAYMENT FOR THE PREVIOUS YEAR, USING THE ABOVE LIMITING SCALE OF 1955-1956 AS A BASE.

- (f) (C) Provided, however, that for the basis of MINI-MUM PAYMENT TO TEACHERS AND OF calculation of payments to the Board of Education of any County or the Mayor and City Council of the City of Baltimore under the Equalization Fund established in Article 77, for every teacher, without a degree, the amounts set forth in the schedules under sub-sections (d) and (e) SUB-SECTION (B) of this section shall be reduced by \$200.00 for each year of teaching experience. And provided further that for the basis of calculation of payments to the Board of Education of any County or the Mayor and City Council of the City of Baltimore Sub-sections (g), (h), (i), (i), (i), (li), (li) and (m) (D), (E), (F), (G), (H), (I) AND (J) of this section shall be applied.
