CHAPTER 270

(Senate Bill 201)

AN ACT to add a new sub-section to Section 187 of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Alcoholic Beverages," sub-title "Penalties," said new sub-section to be known as Sub-section (c) and to follow immediately after Sub-section (b) of said Section 187, providing for the manner in which fines imposed under the provisions of Article 2B shall be disposed of in Carroll, ~~County~~, CECIL ~~AND~~, GARRETT AND TALBOT COUNTIES.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That a new sub-section be and it is hereby added to Section 187 of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1951 Edition), title "Alcoholic Beverages," sub-title "Penalties," said new sub-section to be known as Sub-section (c), to follow immediately after Sub-section (b) of said Section 187, and to read as follows:

187.

(c). (*Carroll*, CECIL ~~AND~~, GARRETT AND TALBOT COUNTIES ~~County~~.) *Provided that in Carroll, CECIL AND, GARRETT AND TALBOT COUNTIES County one-half of each fine shall be disposed of as provided in Section 5 of Article 38 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland (1951 Edition).*

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1953.
